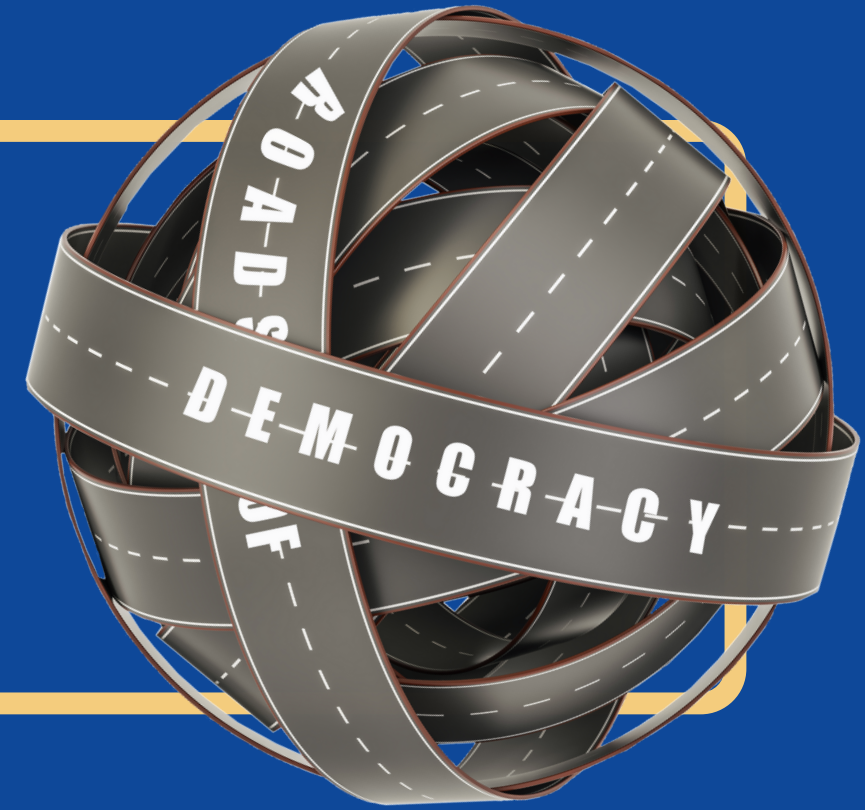

European youth understands democracy as a given state, since dictatorship or any other oppressive regime is part of a distant past or place, away from their daily reality.

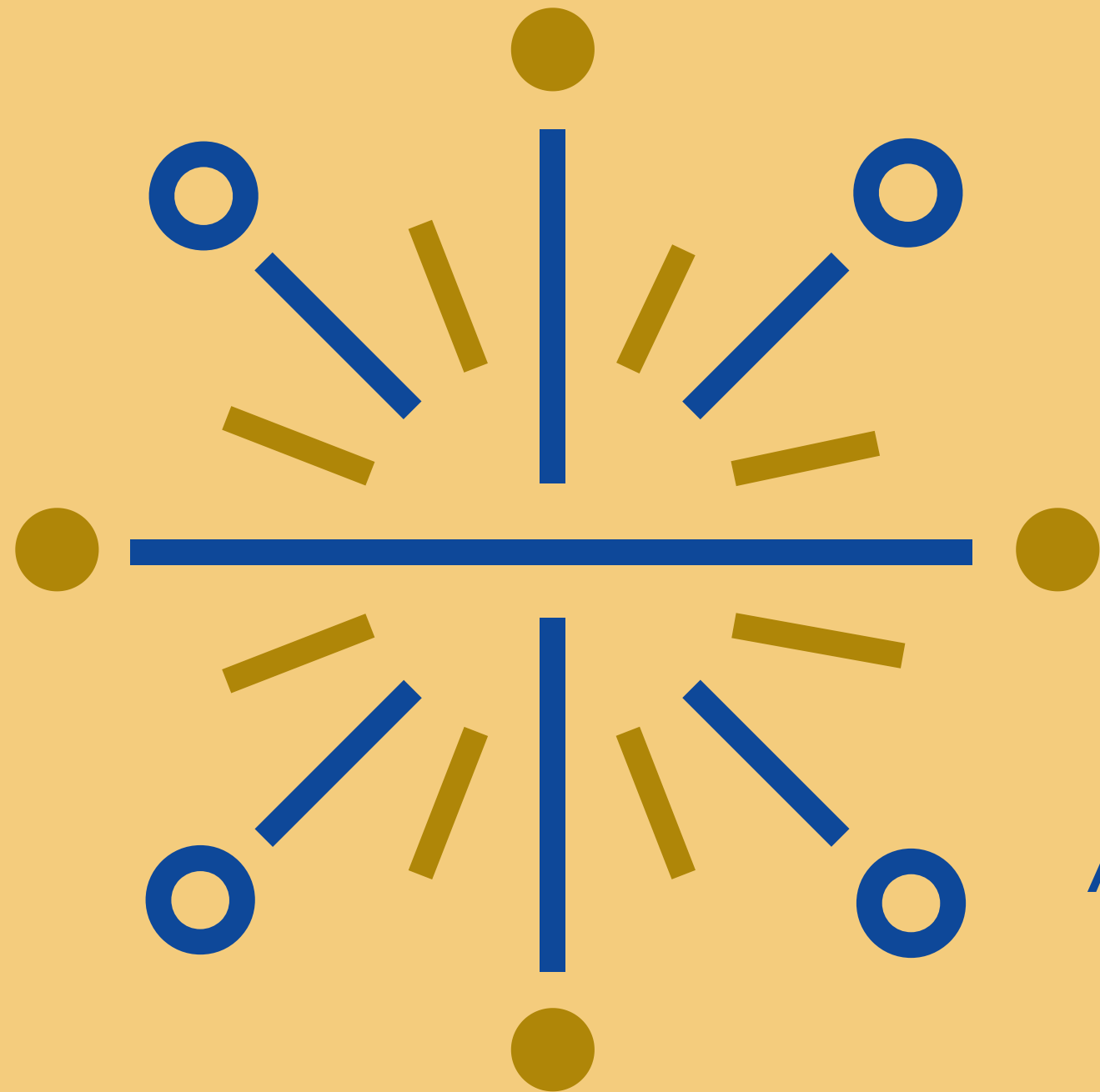
«THEY DON'T GET IT.»

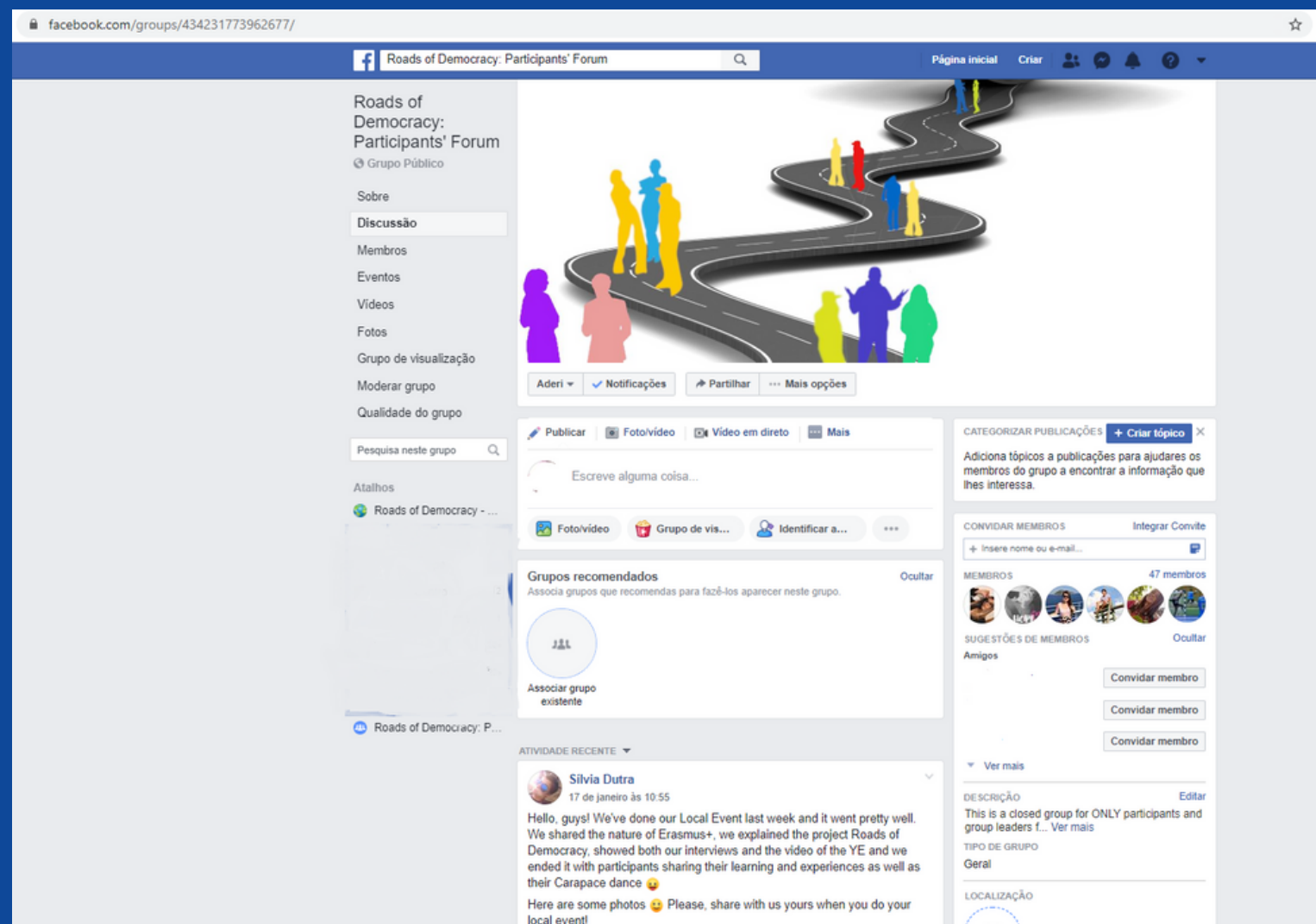

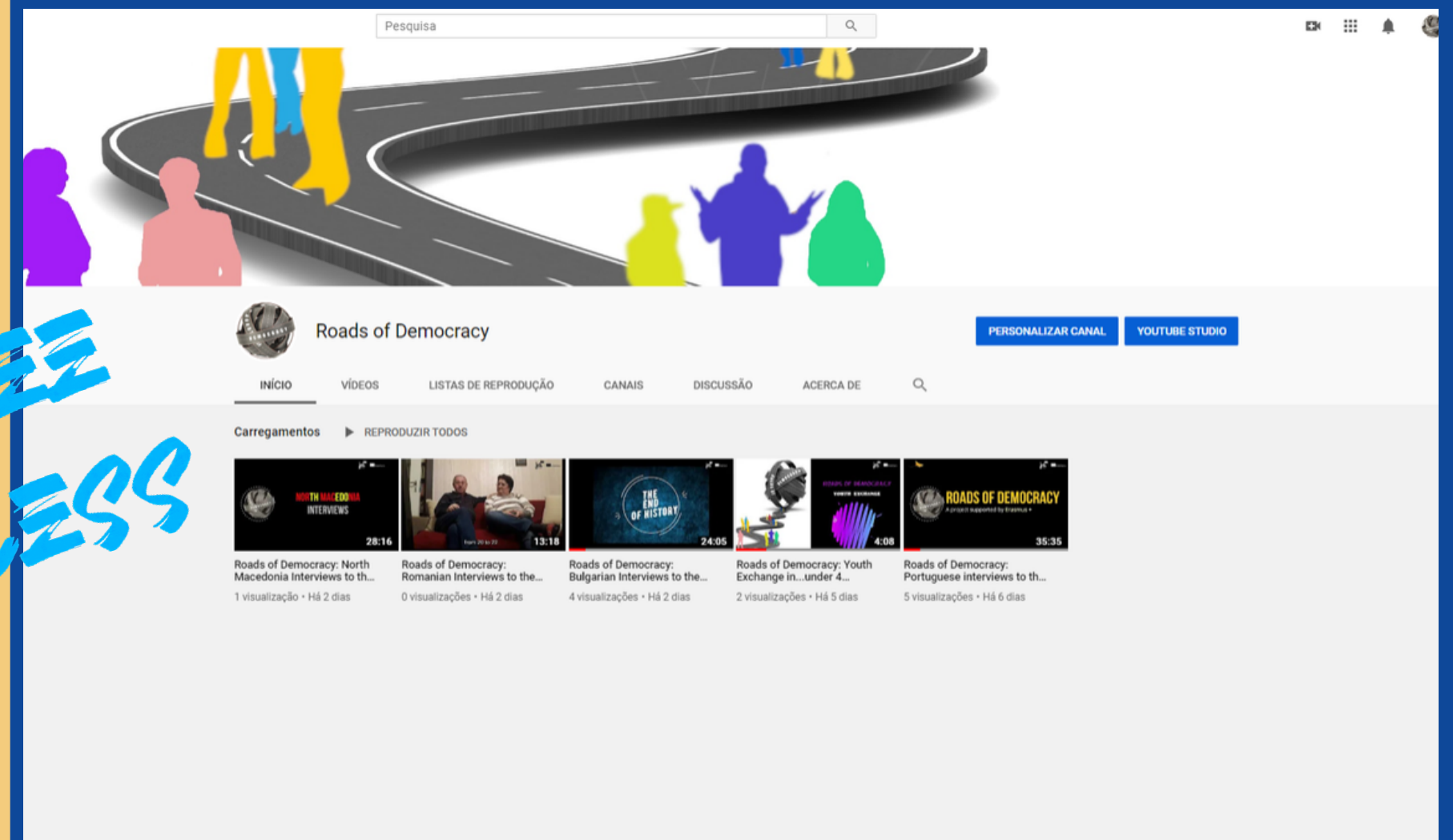

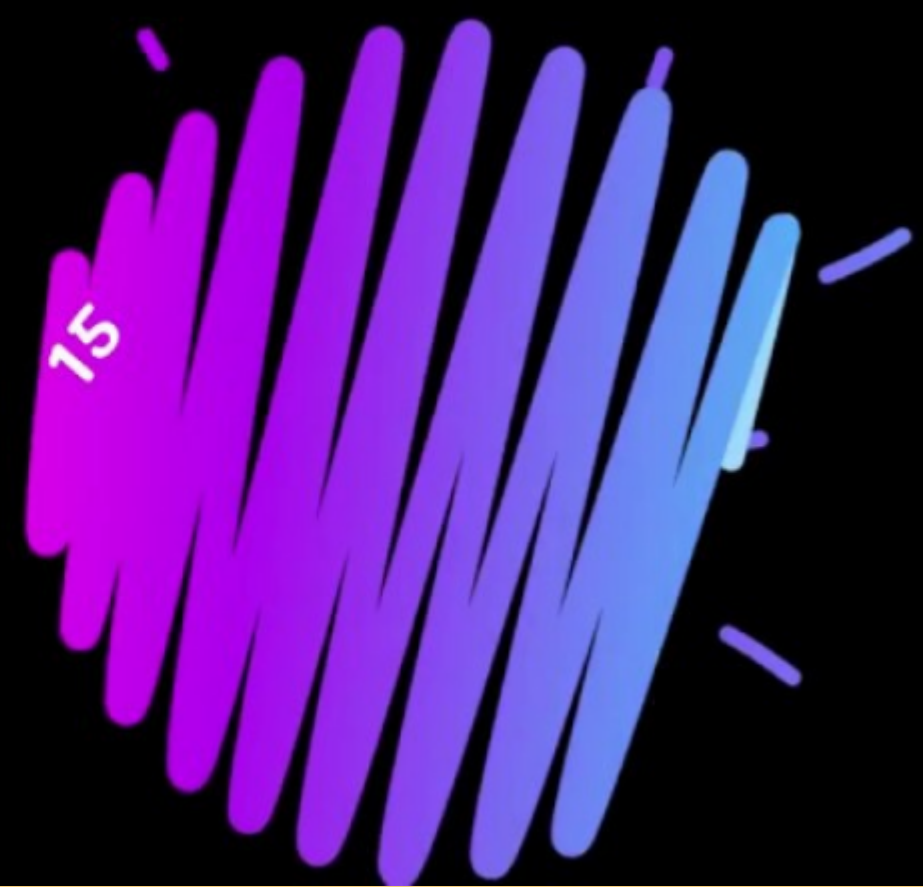

ROADS OF DEMOCRACY YOUTH EXCHANGE



«I learned that I am able to be part of multicultural groups and work towards a common goal. That I am able to participate in discussions and reflections on the opposition between past, present and future.»

«I FEEL LIKE I CAN SPEAK ENGLISH BETTER THAN I THOUGHT!»

«This week I learned to express myself, to discuss in English (I improved my English)! I learned the history of other countries and their culture and how I live today!»

«I learned that I don't have to be so scared and nervous about the kind of activities we do. I think I'm more confident now when I speak English and / or in public.»

«I WAS PUSHED OUT OF MY COMFORT ZONE AND WAS ABLE TO EXPRESS MY OPINION. I HAD TO MIX WITH A LOT OF NEW PEOPLE, WHICH IS NOT SOMETHING I DO ON A DAILY BASIS.»

Intangible Results

«I also learned a lot about how to deal with unexpected situations. I learned that democracy is not perfect despite empowering people.»

«I also improved my English speaking and writing skills. I learned how to talk and how to act in front of a large group of people and also how to make a good presentation.»

«I learned more about their history and how they managed to fight against the dictatorship established in their countries. I also learned new words in other languages, such as Romanian, Portuguese, Bulgarian and Slovak.»

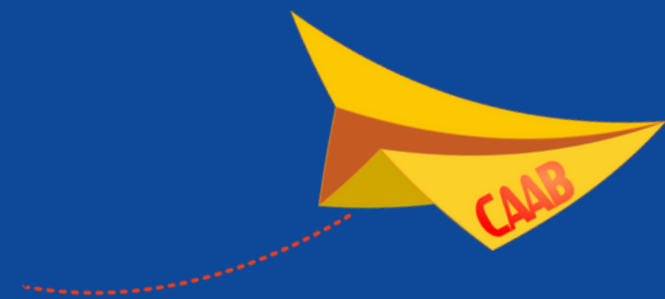
