CAAB WERE IN Aguada de Baixo



CAAB youth did an orientation activity on inclusion in Aguada de Baixo and spoke to the community about inclusion in our village. They had the opportunity to contact directly with other generations and speak in a structured way on this topic. Here are their conclusions:

PEOPLE WERE OPEN TO DIALOGUE

Although with some shyness, everyone collaborated with our young people in their tasks.



THERE IS DISCRIMINATION

Although aimed mainly at an ethnic minority, some people shared that they have already suffered discrimination for coming from another region or for their physical appearance.

DIFFICULTY IN THINKING ABOUT SOLUTIONS

Thinking about activities that bring together different cultures in the community is difficult and all interviewees found it difficult to think about strategies.

CAAB WERE IN ÁGUEDA







With the European volunteers from the Águeda Youth Center, our youth took part in an activity in which they had to imagine a perfect country, with the values they cherish the most.

Common values that were in all countries:

Sustainability Interculturality Dialogue Health Education

It was an important exercise of reflection, imagination and creativity, which allowed them to reflect in groups about what kind of world they would like to help build.
