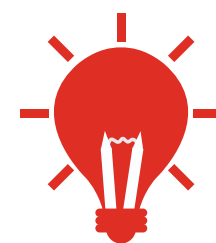

To put a stop on hateful situations and to condemn discriminatory behaviour;

**WHAT WE'VE LEARNT TODAY**

- RESPECT PRIVACY**  
Do not post someone else's personal information or share their experiences without consent.
- BE MINDFUL**  
Avoid posting sensitive information or talking about other people's experiences without permission.
- THINK CRITICALLY**  
Do not believe everything you read or hear. Verify information before sharing or acting on it.
- PROTECT IDENTITY**  
Do not steal or impersonate someone else's identity.
- BE CULTURALLY SENSITIVE:**  
Do not disrespect another person or culture; be open to understanding and appreciating differences.
- MAINTAIN INTEGRITY**  
Avoid posting content that you may later regret or be ashamed of.
- BE RESPECTFUL**  
Refrain from judging others and avoid engaging in conflicts or offensive discussions.
- PROMOTE POSITIVITY**  
Do not support hate speech, spread hate or violence, or push misinformation.

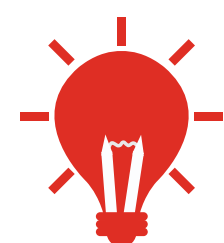

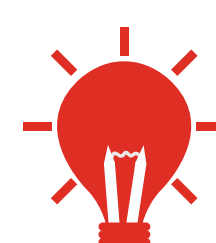
